- It will be recorded for completeness, and will be worth 10% of your child's grade. **

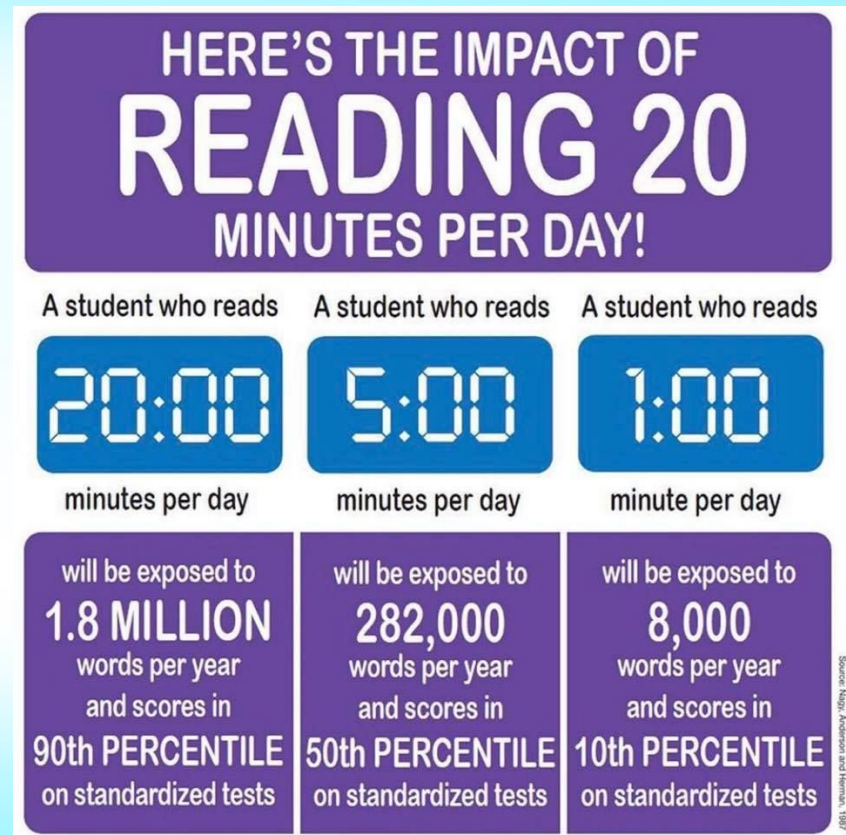
Homework – Math

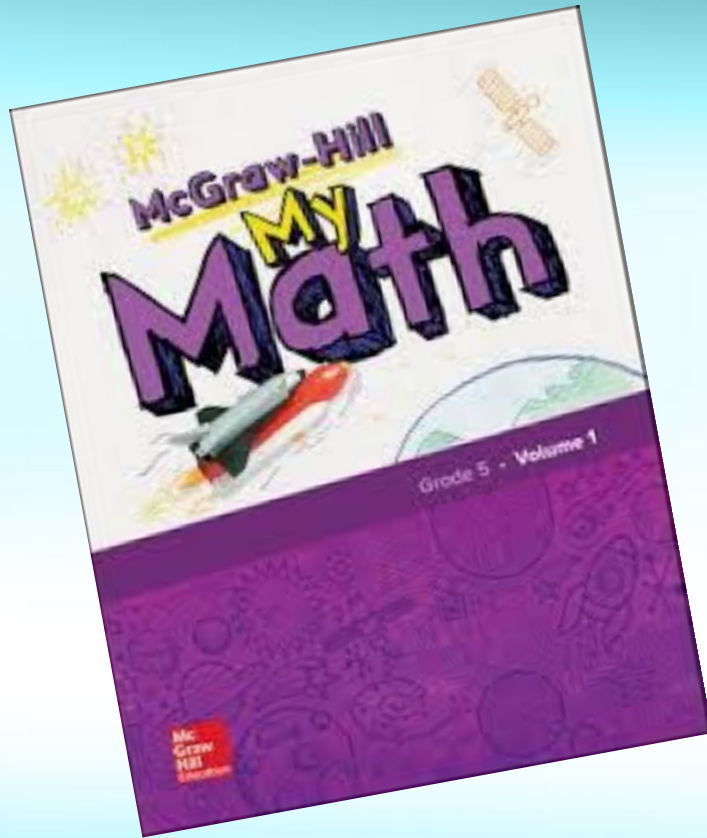
