

Moving Holidays - Like Mother's Day, Father's Day is not a static holiday. It is celebrated on the 3rd Sunday in June. Mother's Day is always the 2nd Sunday in May.

#'s 3 & 4 for Cards - Behind Valentine's Day, and Christmas, Mother's Day is the third and Father's Day is the fourth-largest card-sending holiday in the U.S., according to Hallmark.

Most Popular Gifts - Mother's Day is the 3rd highest selling holiday for flowers and plants. Around approximately one quarter of all the flowers purchased throughout the year are bought for Mother's Day. It also tends to be the busiest day of the year for restaurants. A tie is the most commonly purchased item of clothing for a Father's Day gift, but the 3rd most common gift behind electronic and a day or meal out. After that, gift cards are the next most popular gift for dads on Father's Day.

Origins - Following the Civil War,
Mother's Day was originally
envisioned as a "Mother's Day
for Peace", in which women
would protest against war.
The basis of today's version
was started by Anna Reeves
Jarvis in an effort to honor her
mother, who had called for
"Mothers Work Days" to improve
conditions for soldiers on both
sides during the Civil War. She
persuaded President Woodrow
Wilson to sign Mother's Day
into law in 1914.

Sonora Smart Dodd pushed for an equilvalent observance for fathers in 1910 as a way to celebrate her own father who was a veteran of the Civil War and widower who had raised six children. While there were annual local observances and a national proclamation in 1966, it took until 1972 when President Richard Nixon signed a law to allow for permanent recognition of Father's Day.
