WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Monday:

Small Group: We used shapes to trace, put together and create other shapes like we saw in the book When Sophie Thinks She Can't.

Large Group: We acted out Row, Row, Row Your Boat with partners.

Tuesday

Small group: We sorted colored goldfish and counted how many fish we had for each color. The children worked hard to draw the number to represent the amount of goldfish they had.

Large group: We sang the Bakery Shop Song. The children love to pretend to eat the doughnut they are called to find.

Wednesday:

Small group: We worked with some more magnetic numbers and talked about the straight and curvy lines, the letter name, and then we tried drawing the letter on a piece of paper.

Large group: We sang letter songs. This week we did Bingo and the ABC's. The children love to do the Alphabet song in different voices.

Thursday:

Small group: We measured a tracing of our foot. We used cubes and links to measure the length of our foot.

Large Group: We had an assembly called Peter Pan, put on by the Helen Fort Middle School Students. The children really enjoyed the show.

Friday:

Small group: We used yellow and blue markers to make green for making green for Dr. Seuss Green Day. The children also tried mixing yellow and blue crayons to make green.

Large group: We played Red Light, Green Light.
