### REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a student at PTHS
- The student is required to volunteer within the Pemberton Community, including a Pemberton Township Clean Communities clean-up signed in under the Presidential Lakes Civic Association.

### MAJOR REQUIREMENT:

- Student must be pursuing a degree in one of the following major:
  - Art, Graphic Design, Interior Design, Fashion, Architecture, or Engineering

### GPA:

- Student must have an unweighted GPA of 3.3 or better.

## ESSAY:

- Topic – Explain why you wish to pursue further education in your chosen major and explain your long-term career goals.

## ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS:

- Application linked above and/or available on Scholarship bulletin board in the Counseling Center.
- Copy of transcript
- Recommendations: 2 required (1 teacher and 1 counselor)
- Complete Biographical Sketch which can be found under the "My Portfolio" tab on MajorClarity.
- Student will need to provide proof of enrollment (tuition bill or schedule) at the end of the school year for release of funds.

## Stephanie Marie Trotter Memorial Scholarship Selection Criteria

### Selection:

The Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Committee will select the recipient of our Scholarship Award based on the criteria outlined below.

The Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Committee strictly prohibits all forms of unlawful discrimination and harassment on the basis of race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, age, marital status, domestic partnership status, affectional or sexual orientation, familial status, disability, nationality, sex, pregnancy, gender identity or expression, atypical hereditary cellular or blood trait, genetic information, military service, AIDS and HIV status, or any other point covered under the Boy Scouts of America Equal Access Act.

It is the policy of the Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Committee, that the selection process will be free of any form of discrimination.

### Criteria Requirements for Scholarship Consideration:

- The student must reside within the confines of Pemberton Township.
- The student must attend Pemberton Township High School or Burlington County Institute of Technology through Pemberton Township.
- The student must be pursuing a continuing education in Art, Graphic Design, Interior Design, Fashion, Architecture, or Engineering. Should any student not meet the above criteria, another field of study could be considered, if agreed upon by the Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Committee.
- The student must have a grade of B+ (88), or an unweighted GPA of 3.3 or higher (on a 4.0 scale). Should any student not meet the above criteria, a lesser GPA could be considered, if agreed upon by the Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Committee.
- The student must be recommended by a Teacher.
- The student should also be recommended by a Guidance Counselor.

## **Criteria Requirements for Scholarship Consideration (continued)**

- The student must be accepted and enrolled in a college deemed as acceptable by the Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Committee.
- The student shall submit a biographical portrayal including interests and career goals.
- The student is required to volunteer within the Pemberton Community, including a Pemberton Township Clean Communities clean-up signed in under the Presidential Lakes Civic Association. The student shall submit a listing of community volunteer service within Pemberton Township.
- The student shall submit an essay explaining why they wish to pursue further education studies and explain what his or her long-term plans are for the future.
- Each student, meeting the criteria requirements, shall be prepared to attend an interview with one or more members of the Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Committee, as part of the final selection process.
- The Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Committee will also take into consideration any recommendations made by the student's teachers and guidance counselors.
- The final approval and selection of the student award recipient will be facilitated by the Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Committee.

## **Award Distribution**

- The student shall provide proof of application, acceptance, and enrollment into an acceptable college before any monetary award will be made to the student.
- The Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Committee will provide the name of the scholarship recipient to the organization. Once all criteria requirements have been met by the student, the Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Committee will petition the Treasurer to write a check in the specified amount of the scholarship in the name of the selected student.
- The Presidential Lakes Civic Association will deliver the check directly to the selected student at the Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Awards Luncheon.
- If there is an awards ceremony for scholarships, a Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Committee Member, or a suitable representative thereof, be invited to present the award on behalf of the Trotter family and the PLCA organization.
