REQUIREMENTS:

- Completion of Culinary 1, 2, and 3 at PTHS.
- Must be a student at PTHS

MAJOR REQUIREMENT:

- Student must be pursuing a degree in one of the following major:
 - Culinary Arts

GPA:

- Student must have an unweighted GPA of 3.3 or better.

ESSAY:

- Topic – Explain why you wish to pursue further education in the culinary arts studies and explain your long-term plans in the culinary field.

ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS:

- Application linked above and/or available on Scholarship bulletin board in the Counseling Center.
- Copy of transcript
- Recommendations: 2 required (1 culinary teacher and 1 counselor)
- Complete Biographical Sketch which can be found under the "My Portfolio" tab on MajorClarity.
- Student will need to provide proof of enrollment (tuition bill or schedule) at the end of the school year for release of funds.

William “Roger” Fatum Culinary Arts Scholarship Selection Criteria

Selection

The Presidential Lakes Civic Association Culinary Arts Scholarship Committee will select the recipient of our Scholarship Award based on the criteria outlined below.

The Presidential Lakes Civic Association Culinary Arts Scholarship Committee strictly prohibits all forms of unlawful discrimination and harassment on the basis of race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, age, marital status, domestic partnership status, affectional or sexual orientation, familial status, disability, nationality, sex, pregnancy, gender identity or expression, atypical hereditary cellular or blood trait, genetic information, military service, AIDS and HIV status, or under the Boy Scouts of America Equal Access Act.

It is the policy of the Presidential Lakes Civic Association Culinary Arts Scholarship Committee that the selection process will be free of any form of discrimination.

Criteria Requirements for Scholarship Consideration

- The student must reside within the confines of Pemberton Township.
- The student must attend Pemberton Township High School.
- The student must have completed PTHS Culinary Arts I, or an acceptable equivalent.
- The student must have completed PTHS Culinary Arts II.
- The student must currently enrolled or have completed PTHS Culinary Arts III
- The student must have a grade of B+ (88), or a GPA of 3.3 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) in Culinary Arts. Should any student not meet the above criteria, a lesser GPA could be considered, if agreed upon by the PLCA Scholarship Committee.
- The student must be recommended by a PTHS Culinary Arts Teacher.
- The student must be accepted / enrolled in a Culinary Arts Program at a culinary school, culinary institute, or a college deemed as acceptable by the Presidential Lakes Civic Association Culinary Arts Scholarship Committee.

Criteria Requirements for Scholarship Consideration (continued)

- The student shall submit a biographical portrayal including interests and career goals.
- The student shall submit an essay explaining why they wish to pursue further education in the culinary arts studies and explain what his or her long-term plans are in the culinary field.
- The student is required to volunteer within the Pemberton Community, the student shall submit a listing of community volunteer service within Pemberton Township.
- Each student, meeting the criteria requirements, shall be required to attend an interview with one or more members of the Presidential Lakes Civic Association Scholarship Committee, as part of the final selection process.

Award Distribution

- The student shall provide proof of application, acceptance, and enrollment into a culinary arts program at an acceptable culinary school, culinary institute, or a college culinary arts program before any monetary award will be made to the student.
- The Presidential Lakes Civic Association Culinary Arts Scholarship Committee will provide the name of the scholarship recipient to the Presidential Lakes Civic Association Treasurer. Once all criteria requirements have been met by the student, the President of the Presidential Lakes Civic Association will direct the Treasurer to write a check in the specified amount of the scholarship in the name of the selected student.
- The Presidential Lakes Civic Association will deliver the check, as outlined above, to Pemberton Township High School, 148 Arney's Mount Road, Pemberton, NJ 08068 to be given directly to the selected student.
- If there is an awards ceremony for scholarships, the Presidential Lakes Civic Association requests that a member, or a suitable representative thereof, be invited to present the award on behalf of the organization.
