RETURN COMPLETED APPLICATION GUIDANCE OFFICE

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a student at PTHS
- Attending a 2 or 4 year college/university

ESSAY:

- Topic – See application.

ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS:

- Application linked above and/or available on Scholarship bulletin board in the Counseling Center.
- Copy of transcript
- Recommendations: 3 required
- Complete Biographical Sketch which can be found under the "My Portfolio" tab on MajorClarity.
- Student will need to provide proof of enrollment (tuition bill or schedule) at the end of the school year for release of funds.

OTHER:

- Interview may be required. Committee will contact student to set up meeting.



QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPLICANT

- a. Graduating senior residing within Pemberton Township or Pemberton Borough.
- b. Anticipated graduation from high school in June 2024. (If the applicant is not graduated for any reason, he or she will be dropped from contention for a scholarship.)
- c. Applicant must have applied for, and been accepted for entrance into a two-year or four-year degree seeking program as a full-time student at a college of his or her choice on or before May 24th.
- d. Applicant must be willing to meet with the Pemberton Rotary Foundation Scholarship Committee.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The total amount scholarship funding and the number of scholarships to be awarded will be determined each year by the Pemberton Rotary Foundation Board of Directors.

- a. \$750 for RCBC or \$2,500 scholarship for an accredited college or university.
- b. Allotted amount to be paid to the student attending college.

DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOLARSHIP

- a. \$750 – Outright – One time amount
- b. \$2,500 - Paid over four years; four installments.
- c. Criteria - must remain in good academic standing each semester/year.

TRANSFER OF COLLEGE

If a recipient transfers from the college of original choice, he or she must apply to the Pemberton Rotary Club for continuation of the scholarship.

ALTERNATE

One alternate recipient will be selected. The alternate will take the place of a scholarship recipient if the recipient is unable to enter or to continue college. The alternate will be awarded any remaining balance of a scholarship at any time during the four years if the scholarship recipient leaves school for more than one semester.

FORMS REQUIRED

- a. Application (attached)
- b. Three letters of recommendation (Guidance Counselor, community leader, teacher)
- c. Biographical sketch - including career plans and interests.
- d. Copy of high school transcript
- e. Senior report card for the first three marking periods
- f. Last known grade point average and class rank
- g. Copy of Financial Aid Form (if applied for) or reason not applied for
- h. List of activities including work, community, and school
