Letters were sent to families notifying them of an award or scholarship being awarded.



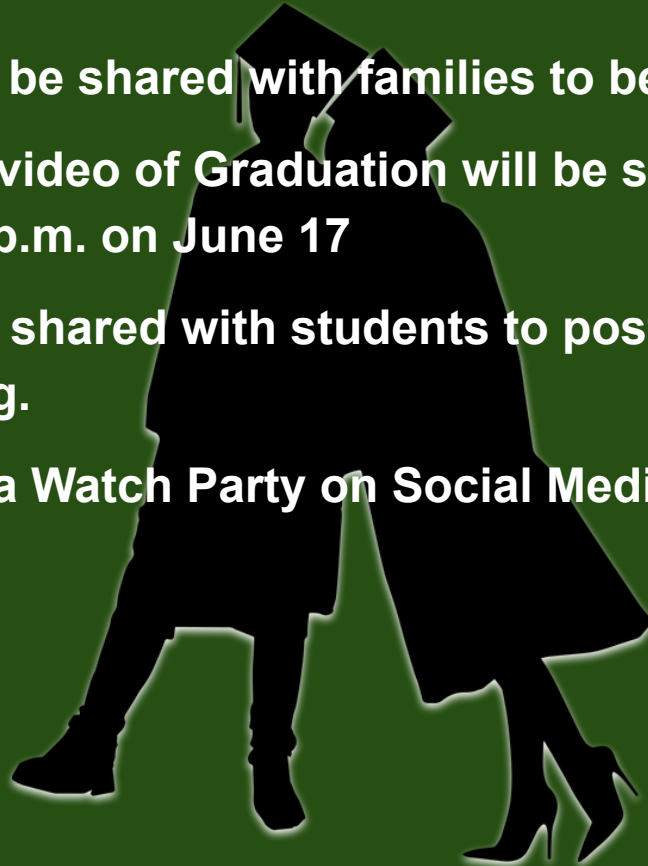


# Virtual Graduation: June 17th

- **Our Graduation ceremony will include Live video recorded speeches by students and faculty members along with other portions of a traditional graduation.**
- **Pre-recorded and shared videos of students “Turning their Tassel and passing their diploma.”**
- **Recognition of students who participated in our CAP program and received college credits.**
- **Recognition of students who are enlisting in the various branches of the Armed Forces.**

# Day of Graduation: June 17th

- A Youtube link will be shared with families to be played on June 17.
- Youtube Premiere video of Graduation will be streamed using the Youtube Link @ 6 p.m. on June 17
- A #Hashtag will be shared with students to post videos and photos using the #Hashtag.
- Families can host a Watch Party on Social Media of the Graduation Event.





# Diploma and Yearbook Distribution: June 18th

- **June 18th between the hours of 1:00 - 5:00 p.m.**
  - **Students must turn in their school issued Chromebook and all obligations such as textbooks, calculators, uniforms etc. to receive their diploma.**
    - **Information will be shared with students and families about obligations needed to be turned in.**
  - **Once all obligations are turned in, school officials will provide seniors with the following.**
    - **Diploma**
    - **Yearbook**
    - **Graduation Program**
    - **Information about “Modified In-Person Graduation”**
  - **Items will ONLY be distributed to the graduating senior or Contact in Genesis.**
  - **Families will be able to sign up in Genesis beginning Monday 6/15**



# In Person Modified Graduation: NJ DOE Guidance (After July 6)

- **Ceremonies must meet the relevant capacity limitation for gathering at the time of graduation. (Governor Murphy projects that it will be set at 500 people)**
- **The ceremony must take place outdoors, and all attendees must remain outdoors during the gathering.**
- **All attendees at the gathering are required to remain six feet apart, excluding immediate family members. Face coverings will be required.**

# **In Person Modified Graduation NJ DOE Guidance (After July 6)**

- **Limiting the number of staff members to only those required to facilitate the planned ceremony.**
- **Limiting gatherings before and after each ceremony, to have time to sanitize before the next ceremony. Students will not be able to congregate after the ceremony and will be required to head to their vehicle in preparation of the next ceremony.**
- **Limit group performances and speakers.**



# **In Person Modified Graduation**

**When: July 8th 2020 (Rain Date) July 9th**

**Where: McDowell Football Field**

**Ceremony 1: 8:30 - 9:15**

**Ceremony 2: 11:00 - 11:45**

**Due to the size of our graduating class, and understanding the importance of family members being at the ceremony we are unable to hold one ceremony with all of our seniors.**
