
"Mrs. Dirkin is truly an advocate for her students, often going above and beyond to provide them with the best services. She is a team player, reliable, focused, and approachable."





"Ms. Houser is dedicated to her students, as well as the school community. She goes out of her way to meet the needs of her students, and continually comes up with innovative approaches."






