PEMBERTON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION



BOARD VACANCY

The Pemberton Township Board of Education will be filling a Board Member vacancy in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:12-15(f) and Board Policy 0143 – Board Member Election and Appointment.

Letters of interest must be submitted to Mr. Daniel Smith, Board Secretary, Pemberton Township Board of Education, 1 Egbert Street, Pemberton, NJ 08068 on or before the close of business on **January 19, 2021**. The length of the term will be February 18, 2021 through the next Reorganization of the Board (January 6, 2022).

The legal requirements to become a school board member:

1. Each member of any board of education shall, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1:
 - a. Be a United States citizen;
 - b. Be a resident of the district for at least one year at the time of election or appointment;
 - c. Be able to read and write;
 - d. Be a registered voter in the district;
 - e. Not be “disqualified” as a voter pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1
 - f. Has not been convicted of any of the crimes or offenses enumerated in N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1 or conspiracy to commit or attempt to commit any of said crimes.

2. Board of education members may not, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-2:
 - a. Be the mayor or a member of the governing body of the municipality, or;
 - b. Have a direct, or indirect, contract with or claim against the board.

Additionally, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-3, if a board member ceases to be a resident of the district, his/her membership on the board shall immediately cease.
