Our school goal is 95.2% (less than 13 students per day) attendance everyday. If a student misses school more than 10% of the attended school days (180), that student is considered chronically absent. Please reach out to Mrs. DiBella or Ms. Gomba if there are any medical concerns that should be documented. I challenge you to reach the goal in regards to your children.

All of our individual classrooms have achieved 17 days of Perfect Attendance and have been celebrated for this accomplishment. Rooms 16 and 19 have counted 2 (17 days of perfect attendance). Also, **125 students** have earned perfect attendance for the marking period. Congratulations families, students, and staff for working toward our school goal!

### Our School Security Officer, Mr. Baker

As we head into December and the colder months, this is when we tend to have less students walking and instead being dropped off and picked up from the school. Please keep in mind that dismissal does not begin until 3:45 (1:45 on early days). We ask that you do not begin to arrive to pick up until 3:40 the earliest. This will allow any staff or visitors to the building to exit the parking lot safely and more importantly for the busses to navigate to their appropriate spot in line to be called. A more favorable option is to park across the street near the park and our crossing guard will safely cross your child over to you, allowing you to have a much smoother and timely departure.

### Just a few reminders:

• Student arrival starts at 9:00 am. Please DO NOT arrive and park in the drop off line prior to 8:50 am. Arriving any earlier disrupts the flow of traffic and staff trying to get to the staff parking lot. Dismissal begins at 3:45 pm. If you are doing everyday pickup, please try not to arrive more than 5 minutes prior to dismissal and do not line up in front of the school until the bell rings as that is a fire lane and needs to remain open as long as possible

- Please have and show a valid form of ID EVERY time you pick up your child from the building.
- If you have someone pick up your child other than you (the parent/guardian) they MUST be on your emergency list. Exceptions will only be made on a case by case basis and with a note signed by the parent/guardian sent in advance or an email to either the security office (sbaker@pemb.org) or main office (smcguinness@pemb.org) from the parents Genesis registered email address.
