

Return to School Guidelines

Situation	Returning to School Criteria
<p>Individual has symptoms noted on the attestation form AND tests negative for COVID-19. If you are tested, please stay at home at least until your test results come back.</p>	<p>Individual can return to school if all 3 criteria are met:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Individual has not had direct contact with a positive COVID-19 case. AND 2. Fever free for at least 24 hours, without the use of fever-reducing medication. AND 3. Improvement in all other symptoms. ***Documentation of negative test results must be provided to the school nurse and HR department. ***
<p>Individual has symptoms noted on the attestation form. AND Visits medical provider. AND Does not receive a COVID-19 test.</p>	<p>Individual can return to school if all 3 criteria are met:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Medical provider supplies a medical note that clears you for return based on an alternative diagnosis for symptoms. AND 2. Improvement in all other symptoms. AND 3. Fever free for at least 24 hours, without the use of fever-reducing medication. ***Documentation of alternative diagnosis must be provided to the school nurse and HR department. ***
<p>Individual has symptoms noted on the attestation form. AND Does NOT visit medical provider. AND Does not receive a COVID-19 test.</p>	<p>Individual can return to school if all 3 criteria are met:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Stay home for 10 days. AND 2. Improvement in all other symptoms. AND 3. Fever free for at least 24 hours, without the use of fever-reducing medication.
<p>Individual tests positive for COVID-19.</p>	<p>Individual can return to school if all 3 criteria are met:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared. AND 2. Fever-free for 24 hours, without the use of fever-reducing medication. AND 3. Improvement in symptoms.
